#### DO YOUR PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE!

#### INSIDE:

Take care of household appliances (stove, refrigerator, washer, dryer) and major heating, electrical, and plumbing systems, so they continue to provide you with quality services. Follow Manufacturer's guides for regular services and maintenance, and report problems immediately, while they are small.

#### **OUTSIDE:**

Pay close attention to the outside of your house and watch for roof and gutter problems. Slow wear and tear can lead to serious, and expensive problems. A small roof leak that is not repaired can cause ceiling beams to warp - that could lead to cracked ceilings and inner wall damage, and that could lead to BIG PROBLEMS.

### Home Maintenance Checklist

DATE	WHAT TO CHECK	WHEN
CHECKED:	Foundations	
	Base of your home on the outside, for soft, chipped or rotten wood which could be a sign of termites.	Annually
	The ground around your home to insure it is built up around your foundation so water runs away from your home.	Annually
	Interior walls and floors for signs of water damage.	Annually
	Tree roots that are growing near or under the foundation.	Annually
	Doors & Windows	
	Doors, windows and trim for decay or rot. Caulk any if necessary.	Fall
	Lubricate window hardware and check window glass for loose putty	Fall
	Windows and doors for broken glass and damaged screens	Fall
	Weather stripping for damage and tightness of fit.	Fall
	Clean window and door screens	Fall
	Check and repair or replace weather-stripping on doors	Fall
	Check and tighten door hardware and lubricate as necessary	Fall/Spring
	Tighten all bolts on garage door	Fall/Spring
	Exterior Walls	
	Wall masonry for cracks and loose joints	Fall
	Painted surfaces for chipping and peeling	Fall
	Siding and trim for damage or decay, and tightness of fit	Fall
	Roof and Attic Using a roofing profesional is recommended to avoid damage to your roof!	
	SHINGLES: Check for damaged, loose &/or bubbled shingles	Fall
	TILE: Check for loose, hanging or broken tile.	Every 6 months
	Attic and ceiling for water stains or dampness	Fall
	Skylights & flashing for damage (metal around chimney, vents, etc.)	0.000.000.000
	Low tree limbs brushing against roof	As Needed
	Attic insulation - move insulation back to original location if moved	Fall
	Damage or debris (ie. birds nests in valley, flashings, gutters and downspouts; have cleaned by a roofing professional annually	Every 6 months
	Interior Surfaces	
	All joints & caulking in ceramic tile, laminates, and simillar surfaces	Fall
	Caulk or grouting around tubs, showers, and sinks	Fall/Spring
	Electrical System	
	Condition of lamp cords, extension cords, and plugs for damage	As Needed
	Fuses or breakers which trip frequently	As Needed
	If you feel a shock or tingling from touching any appliance, disconnect it immediately and call a professional	
	Heating and Cooling System	
	Clean or change air filters	Every 30-45 days
	Remove debris from around units	Fall/Spring
	Arrange for regular servicing by qualified professionals	Spring
	Water heater for leaks	Annually
	Plumbing System	
	Hoses for leaks	Annually
	Faucets for leaks	Annually
	Outdoors	
	Fences - posts, gates, and slats for deterioration, damaged paint	Fall
	Safety	
	Smoke Detectors: Check, replace & recycle dead batteries	Monthly
	Inspect fire extinguishers	Annually
